BIOGRAFIJA

Selma Jakupović je rođena 03.09.1967. godine u Tuzli, gdje je završila osnovnu i srednju medicinsku školu. Medicinski fakultet u Tuzli upisala je 1986. godine i diplomirala 08.01.1993. godine. Od 26. maja 1992. godine nakon početka ratnih dejstava, kao apsolvent Medicinskog fakulteta počela je volontirati na Hirurškoj klinici u Tuzli, a po završetku studija 08.01.1993. godine počela je raditi na Neurohirurškom odjeljenju Hirurške klinike u Tuzli. 14. Februara 1994. godine položila je Državni ispit. Petogodišnju specijalizaciju iz neurohirurgije počela je 1995. godine. U okviru programa specijalizacije dio edukacije u trajanju od dvije godine i tri mjeseca obavila je u Francuskoj. Prof. Jan, šef neurohiruške klinike u Tours-u, Francuska, boravio je u Tuzli u junu 1994. godine u radnoj posjeti u okviru humanitarne misije organizovane od strane MDM („Ljekari svijeta“), na čiji poziv je otišla na edukaciju u Francusku. Prvi dio u periodu od oktobra 1995. do novembra 1996. godine

obavila je na Neurohirurškoj klinici Univerzitetske bolnice u Tours-u, drugi dio na istoj klinici u periodu od novembra 1997. do novembra 1998. godine. U Tours-u je bila upisana na Univerzitet, na program edukacije za ljekare specijalizante-strane državljanke, po završetku edukacije stekla je diplomu.

U toku 1998. godine aktivno je participirala na dva svjetska kongresa neurohirurga, na 48. Kongresu neurohirurga frankofona u Nantes-u (Francuska-juni 1998) i na Svjetskom kongresu Neurohirurga u Seatlu (SAD-oktobar 1998). Na oba kongresa rad je prihavačen za oralnu prezentaciju.

1997. godine učestvovala je u uspostavljanju saradnje između UKC Tuzla i Univerzitetske bolnice u Strasbourg. Dodatnu edukaciju u trajanju od tri mjeseca obavila je u Strasbourg u periodu od 01.03.-01.06.2000. na Neurohirurškoj klinici – Prof Maitrot.

12.03.2001. godine pred komisijom Ministarstva zdravstva BiH, položila je specijalistički ispit iz neurohirurgije i stekla zvanje-ljekar specijalista neurohirurg.

2002. godine bila je član Organizacionog odbora Prvog kongresa neurologa (sa internacionalnim učešćem), gdje je bila organizovana neurohirurška sekcija uz prisustvo 10 eminentnih profesora iz Francuske, Njemačke i SAD-a.

2003. godine pohađala je drugi dio VI Europskog postdiplomskog kursa iz pedijatrijske neurohirurgije koji je održan u Dubrovniku.

2004. godine nakon apliciranja na Konkurs objavljen od strane Soroš fondacije kao jedina iz Bosne i Hercegovine, prisustvovala je Seminaru iz neurohirurgije u Salzburg-u (Austrija), koji je organizovan od strane Weill Medical College Cornell Univerziteta New York u saradnji sa Austrijskom fondacijom.

Na poziv Prof. Kehrli-a (koordinatora saradnje između Univerzitetske bolnice u Strasbourg i UKC Tuzla) radila je kao ljekar specijalista – neurohirurg na Neurohirurškoj klinici u Strasbourg u periodu od 01.11.2006.-01. 05. 2007. godine.

Pohađala je Postdiplomski studij na Medicinskom fakultetu u Tuzli.

04. 12. 2009. godine odbranila je magistarski rad pod nazivom „Dijagnostičke karakteristike meningeoma baze lobanje i ishod operativnog liječenja“ i stekla zvanje magistra nauka.

2012. godine promovirana je u zvanje Primarijus.

2014. završila je prvi stepen Škole menađmenta.

Član je Udruženja neurohirurga Bosne i Hercegovine.

Aktivno se služi francuskim i engleskim jezikom.

Trenutno radi kao ljekar specijalista-neurohirurg, šef odjeljenja za dječiju neurohirurgiju na Klinci za neurohirurgiju JZU UKC Tuzla.

BIOGRAPHY

Selma Jakupović was born 03.09.1967. in Tuzla, where she finished primary school and secondary medical school. She graduated at Tuzla University School of Medicine, and complete residency training in neurosurgery at University Clinical Center Tuzla.

From 26 May 1992 after the start of the war, as a graduate student School of Medicine began to volunteer at the Surgical Clinic in Tuzla, and after graduation 08.01.1993. she begins to work on neurosurgical department of Surgical Clinic in Tuzla. On February 14th 1994 she passed the state exam. Five-year residency in neurosurgery began in 1995. As part of the specialization part of training for a period of two years and three months was conducted in France. Prof. Jan, head of the Neurosurgery Clinic in Tours in France, visited Tuzla in a working visit as part of a humanitarian mission organized by MDM ("Medecins du monde"), and he invited docteur Jakupovic to come in France for education in neurosurgery. The first part of the period from October 1995 to November 1996 was conducted at the Clinic of Neurosurgery of the University Hospital in Tours, the second part of the same clinic between November 1997 to November 1998. She was registered at the University, the training program for doctors-residents foreigners, upon completion of training acquired a diploma. In 1998 he actively participated in two World Congress of Neurosurgeons, the 48th Congress of Neurosurgeons Francophone in Nantes (France-juni 1998) and the World Congress of Neurosurgery in Seatllu (US, October 1998).

1997. participated in the establishment of cooperation between the UCC Tuzla and the University Hospital of Strasbourg. Additional training for a period of three months carried out in Strasbourg, during the period from March 1 to June 1, 2000. at the Clinic of Neurosurgery. 12.03.2001. she passed the exam, and obtained the title-doctor specialist neurosurgeon. 2002. she was a member of the Organizing Committee of the First Congress of neurologists (with international participation), which was organized Neurosurgery section in the presence

of 10 eminent professors from France, Germany and the United States. 2003. attended the second part of VI of the European Postgraduate Course in Pediatric Neurosurgery, in Dubrovnik.

2004. after applying for the competition announced by the Soros Foundation as the only from Bosnia and Herzegovina, attended the neurosurgical seminar in Salzburg (Austria), which was organized by the Weill Medical College of Cornell University in New York in cooperation with the Austrian Foundation. Grace the invitation of Prof. Kehrli's (coordinator of cooperation between the University Hospital of Strasbourg and UCC Tuzla) she worked as a doctor-specialist - neurosurgeon at the Clinic of Neurosurgery in Strasbourg during the period of

01.11.2006.-the 01. 05 2007.

After attending postgraduate studies at the Faculty of Medicine in Tuzla.

04. 12. 2009. defends master's thesis entitled "Diagnostic characteristics of skull base meningioma and outcome of surgical treatment", and obtained the title of Master of Science.

2014 completed the first stage of the School management. She is member of the Association of Neurosurgeons of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Currently working as a specialist doctor-neurosurgeon, head of Department of pediatric neurosurgery at University Clinical Center Tuzla.
