Mirsad Hodžić završio je Medicinski fakultet Univerziteta u Tuzli (1991) i specijalizaciju iz neurohirurgije u Univerzitetskom kliničkom centru Tuzla (2000). Šestomjesečnu specijalizaciju iz neurohirurgije završio je na Klinici za neurohirurgiju Univerzitetu New York u Buffalu (SAD) (1996). Jednogodišnju specijalizaciju iz neurohirurgije završio je u okviru projekta German Academic Exchange Service (Deutsher Akademischer Austauschdienst – DAAD) na Klinici za neurohirurgiju Guenzburg Univerziteta u Ulmu (Njemačka) (1998/1999). Kao izvanredni mladi znanstvenik sudjelovao na 49. sjednici dobitnika Nobelove nagrade u Lindau (Njemačka) (1999). Jednomjesečnu edukaciju završio je u Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center u Buffalu (SAD) (2001). Dobitnik je stipendije Američke asocijациje neurohirurga (AANS International Visiting Surgeons Fellowship) u okviru koje je završio tromjesečnu specijalizaciju iz dječje neurohirurgije u bolnici Kaleida Health's Women & Children's Hospital u Buffalu (2007). Jednomjesečnu edukaciju iz vaskularne neurohirurgije završio je u Gate Vascular Institute u Buffalu (SAD) (2013). Diplomirao je na Školi zdravstvenog menadžmenta Univerziteta u Sarajevu pod pokroviteljstvom Federalnog ministarstva zdravstva (SHCE-3) (2017). Dr. Hodžić je certificirani neurohirurg od strane Federalnog ministarstva zdravlja Bosne i Hercegovine. U svom neurohirurškom radu bavi se istraživanjem i liječenjem tumora mozga, cerebrovaskularnih bolesti, dječjom neurohirurgijom, hirurgijom perifernih nerava, razvojnim anomalijama centralnog nervnog sistema, degenerativnim bolestima i tumorima kralježnice. Član je Njemačkog udruženja neurohirurga (Deutsche Gesellschaft fur Neurochirurgie), Udruženja neurohirurga jugoistočne Evrope (SEENS) i član Udruženja neurohirurga u Bosni i Hercegovini (UNUBiH). Dr. Hodžić je autor ili koautor preko 90 originalnih radova publikovanih u medicinskim časopisima, revijalnih radova i poglavlja u knjigama. Trenutno obavlja dužnost načelnika Klinike za neurohirurgiju Univerzetskog kliničkog centra Tuzla, ima zvanje redovnog

profesora na Medicinskom fakultetu Univerziteta u Tuzli i stalni je sudski vještak medicinske struke podoblast neurohirurgija.

Mirsad Hodžić graduated from the Medical Faculty of the University of Tuzla (1991) and specialized in neurosurgery at the University Clinical Center Tuzla (2000). He completed a six-month specialization in neurosurgery at Department of neurosurgery University New York at Buffalo (USA) (1996). He completed a one-year specialization in neurosurgery as part of the German Academic Exchange Service (Deutsher Akademischer Austauschdienst - DAAD) project at the Clinic of Neurosurgery at the University of Ulm in Guenzburg (Germany) (1998/1999). He had the opportunity to join the 49th annual gathering of Nobel Laureates at Lindau (Germany) provided exclusively to outstanding young scientists aged up to 35 (1999). He completed a one-month education at the Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center in Buffalo (USA) (2001). He is a recipient of a scholarship from the American Association of Neurosurgeons (AANS International Visiting Surgeons Fellowship) as part of which he completed a three-month specialization in pediatric neurosurgery at Kaleida Health's Women & Children's Hospital in Buffalo (2007). He completed a one-month education in vascular neurosurgery at the Gate Vascular Institute in Buffalo (USA) (2013). He graduated from the School of Health Management of the University of Sarajevo under the auspices of the Federal Ministry of Health (SHCE-3) (2017). Dr. Hodzic is a certified neurosurgeon by the Federal Ministry of Health of Bosnia and Herzegovina. In his neurosurgical work, he researches and treats brain tumors, cerebrovascular diseases, pediatric neurosurgery, peripheral nerve surgery, developmental anomalies of the central nervous system, degenerative diseases and spinal tumors. He is a member of the German Association of Neurosurgeons (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Neurochirurgie), the Association of Neurosurgeons of Southeast Europe (SEENS) and a member of the Association of Neurosurgeons in Bosnia and Herzegovina (UNUBiH). Dr. Hodzic is the author or co-author of over 90 original papers published in medical journals, review papers and book chapters. He is currently the head of the Clinic for Neurosurgery of the University Clinical Center Tuzla, has the title of full professor at the Medical Faculty of the University of Tuzla and is a permanent forensic expert in the field of neurosurgery.
