Biografija

Prof.dr.sc. Mirsad Hodžić je završio Medicinski fakultet Univerziteta u Tuzli (1991) i specijalizaciju iz neurohirurgije u Univerzitetskom kliničkom centru Tuzla (2000).

Kao stipendista American International Health Alliance (AIHA) završio je šestomjesečnu specijalizaciju iz neurohirurgije na Klinici za neurohirurgiju Univerziteta New York u Buffalu (SAD) (1996). Jednogodišnju specijalizaciju iz neurohirurgije završio je pod pokroviteljstvom German Academic Exchange Service (Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst – DAAD) na Klinici za neurohirurgiju Guenzburg Univerziteta u Ulmu (Njemačka) (1998/1999). U okviru DAAD-a je kao izvanredni mladi znanstvenik sudjelovao na 49. sjednici dobitnika Nobelove nagrade u Lindau (Njemačka) (1999). Jednomjesečnu edukaciju iz neuroonkologije završio je u Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center u Buffalu (SAD) (2001). Pod pokroviteljstvom Američke asocijacije neurohirurga (AANS International Visiting Surgeons Fellowship) završio je tromjesečnu specijalizaciju iz dječije neurohirurgije u bolnici Kaleida Health's Women & Children's Hospital u Buffalu i (2007). Edukaciju iz mikrovaskularne neurohirurgije završio je u Gate Vascular Institute u Buffalu (SAD) (2013). Diplomirao je na Ekonomskom fakultetu Univerziteta u Sarajevu iz oblasti Kontinuirana profesionalna edukacija iz zdravstvenog menadžmenta pod pokroviteljstvom Federalnog ministarstva zdravstva (SHCE-3) (2017). Prof. Hodžić je certificirani neurohirurg od strane Federalnog ministarstva zdravlja Bosne i Hercegovine. U svom neurohirurškom radu bavi se istraživanjem i liječenjem tumora mozga, cerebrovaskularnih bolesti, dječijom neurohirurgijom, hirurgijom perifernih nerava, razvojnim anomalijama nervnog sistema, degenerativnim bolestima i tumorima kralježnice. Član je Njemačkog udruženja neurohirurga (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Neurochirurgie), Udruženja neurohirurga jugoistočne Evrope (SEENS), Bosanskohercegovačko-američke

asocijacije nauke i umjetnosti (BHAAAS) i član Udruženja neurohirurga u Bosni i Hercegovini (UNUBiH). Autor je ili koautor preko 100 originalnih radova publikovanih u medicinskim časopisima, revijalnih radova i poglavlja u knjigama. Uposlenik je Klinike za neurohirurgiju Univerzitetskog kliničkog centra Tuzla, redovni profesor Medicinskog fakulteta Univerziteta u Tuzli i stalni je sudski vještak medicinske struke podoblast neurohirurgija.

Prof. Mirsad Hodžić graduated from the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Tuzla (1991) and specialized in neurosurgery at the University Clinical Center Tuzla (2000). As a fellow of the American International Health Alliance (AIHA), he completed a six-month residency in neurosurgery at the Department of Neurosurgery State University New York at Buffalo (SUNYAB) (USA) (1996). He completed a one-year specialization in neurosurgery under the auspices of the German Academic Exchange Service (Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst – DAAD) at the Department of Neurosurgery Guenzburg of the University of Ulm (Germany) (1998/1999). Within the framework of the DAAD, as an outstanding young scientist, he participated in the 49th session of Nobel Prize winners in Lindau (Germany) (1999). He completed a one-month training in neuro-oncology at the Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center in Buffalo (USA) (2001). Under the auspices of the American Association of Neurosurgeons (AANS International Visiting Surgeons Fellowship), he completed a three-month residency in pediatric neurosurgery at Kaleida Health's Women & Children's Hospital in Buffalo in (2007). He completed his training in microvascular neurosurgery at the Gate Vascular Institute in Buffalo (USA) (2013). He graduated from the Faculty of Economics of the University of Sarajevo in the field of Continuing Professional Education in Health Management under the auspices of the Federal Ministry of Health (SHCE-3) (2017). Prof. Hodžić is a certified neurosurgeon by the Federal Ministry of Health of Bosnia and Herzegovina. In his neurosurgical work, he deals with research and treatment of brain tumors, cerebrovascular diseases, pediatric neurosurgery, peripheral nerve surgery, developmental anomalies of the nervous system, degenerative diseases and spinal tumors. He is a member of the German Association of Neurosurgeons (Deutsche Gesellschaft für

Neurochirurgie), the Southeast Europe Association of Neurosurgical Societies (SEENS), the Bosnian-Herzegovinian-American Association of Art and Science (BHAAAS) and a member of the Association of Neurosurgeons in Bosnia and Herzegovina (UNUBH). He is the author or co-author of over 100 original works published in medical journals, review papers and book chapters. He is an employee of the Neurosurgery Clinic of the Tuzla University Clinical Center, a full professor at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Tuzla and a permanent expert in the field of neurosurgery.
